Hello, Friends, Family, and Prayer Partners,

We are sending this to all of our different mailing lists, so if you are on more than one, you will likely get more than one copy. Here are several important items that may need your attention:

- 1. Mail: -- Between last year's from Missouri to Arizona and our temporary move to Greer for the season, we have found that the USPS mail forwarding service is not that reliable. Several of our friends have had their letters returned to them, or not forwarded to us. So ---- for now, . . . Please send ALL mail to either us personally OR to Life Unlimited Ministries, using this address: ---- Post Office Box 184, Greer, AZ, 85927.
- 2. Ministry: We are doing just fine, focusing our energies on Greer Chapel, Bob's writing, and our special Ukraine Support ministry to our numerous friends who are helping war victims throughout the country. We are still receiving funds for that.
- 3. Ukraine Support: -- We praise the Lord that so far during the war God has enabled us (via contributions to Life Unlimited Ministries) to give over \$17,000 to a number of our ministry friends as they try to meet the needs of war-ravaged widows, young mothers, churches, and others. So far we've been able to help 1) Two churches in L'viv housing refugees and taking aid into dangerous areas of Ukraine, 2) A seminary in L'viv housing and feeding over 200 refugees, 3) A family near Kyiv living in their dacha (Summer garden shed/cottage) as he helps transport refugees via train, 4) Longtime friends supervising aid distribution through a network of pastors to an area hid very hard west of Kyiv, 5) Two Ukrainian pastor friends who are supervising aid distribution to some 20 villages south of Kyiv where 5,000+ homes were destroyed or damaged, 6) A friend in Kyiv who works with a children's hospital for kids waiting for organ transplants; we help buy medicines, 7) A former Bible college student friend who is housing widows in two houses and also makes dangerous runs with aid into eastern Ukraine.

There are other needs we have been unable to help yet. We have always seen Life Unlimited Ministries as being a "shipping dock" ministry where trucks come in and unload, and we put it on other trucks to send out. We will continue doing that as long as God provides.

We know this is going to be a long, drawn-out war with long term needs, so please pray with us that God will touch hearts and give generously so we can continue as long as possible. We have already received several reports from friends in Ukraine that the generosity from the West has significantly dropped already. We are trying to follow the biblical principle -- "as long as there is a need to be met, there is the need to give."

Finally: -- Please make note of our current mailing address in effect through September (we'll return to Yuma in early October), and if you feel God is impressing you to help us with the special needs in Ukraine (100% of what comes in goes there), just let us know. If you write a check, be sure to put "Ukraine Project" on the memo line. Contact us through the info upper right.
